## JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

The Lincoln County Sheriff's Office is accepting job applications for **Patrol and Corrections Deputies**.

The Lincoln County Sheriff's Office is looking for responsible people who are looking for a unique and challenging job as a Patrol Deputy or Corrections Deputy. Deputy Sheriffs must work a variety of shifts and interact with unique individuals. They must be assertive and willing and able to make quick decisions under stressful circumstances. There are current openings for these positions, and an eligible list will be developed for future openings if suitable candidates are found.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Graduation from high school or obtain GED. Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) certification desirable, but not required.

**MINIMUM AGE:** 21 years old by time of appointment [per NAC (Nevada Administrative Code) 289.110]

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS:** In addition to the minimum requirements and the job duties listed for this position, the following are required: sufficient mobility to handle altercations and work in a police setting and use standard equipment required of the job, vision to read printed materials and hearing and speech to communicate in person and over the telephone. NO accommodation can be made for these physical demands.

**DRIVER'S LICENSE:** Must have a valid driver's license by time of appointment.

Testing procedures and other requirements may include: Written exam and Physical exam. The written exam will consist of a written test weighted 100%. After completion of the written test, the Lincoln County Sheriff's Department will conduct a physical agility test. The physical agility test requirements are the Nevada POST Standard requirements.

If candidates pass the written exam and physical exam, the candidates will be scheduled for an oral board exam. Candidates then must submit to an extensive background investigation conducted by the sheriff's office. Candidates will be required to complete a truthfulness verification examination and a psychological examination. Candidates may be required to pass an extensive medical examination prior to hiring. Any candidate that does not pass these requirements will be removed from the eligible list.

**SPECIAL NOTE:** Employees must be willing to work overtime, shifts, weekends and holidays. Employment is contingent on satisfactory completion of a one year probationary period and a field training program. Must maintain a home telephone number or cellular telephone number.

Lateral transfers will be considered for qualified applicants who possess current POST certifications.
